CALL FOR STUDENT AWARDS 2010

APPLICATIONS ARE NOW BEING REQUESTED FOR THE FOLLOWING MONETARY AWARDS. Applications must be received by September 10th, 2010. The BCAC Awards committee will review applications and make recommendations for approval of the BCAC Board. Awards will be presented at the Annual Silver Wings Banquet scheduled for November 4, 2010.

Note: not all awards will necessarily be presented each year and minimum criteria must be met to be eligible.

A. COMMERCIAL PILOT - FLIGHT TRAINING_AL MICHAUD MEMORIAL BURSARY – \$1,000.00

Basic Nominating Criteria:

High academic standing. Mark(s) including PPL _____(Include mark transcripts – copy ok)

Include remarks on the following items in an attached narrative:

- Superior flying skills.
- Excellence in airmanship.
- Actively engaged in commercial pilot training.
- Needs financial assistance to continue training.
- Has demonstrated a commitment to continue with commercial pilot training to obtain license.

Note: A supporting narrative from the student nominee indicating her/his responses to these criteria would be appreciated

B. Barry and Jim AVIATION MAINTENANCE GRADUATE BURSARY \$3,000.00

Basic Criteria:

- Nominee is a recent graduate from an Aviation Maintenance Engineering (AME) Program in British Columbia.
- Nominee will have overcome some great personal challenge(s) in order to complete the program.

C. BC Airports Managers Association—AIRPORT OPERATIONS/MANAGEMENT Training Bursary -- \$1,000.00

Basic Criteria:

Student has completed at least one year (or equivalent) at an educational institution in the above discipline and has at least one more year to complete the training course.

Grade average mark _____ (attach copy of transcript)

Include remarks on the following items in an attached narrative:

- Student has financial need.
- Student has demonstrated personal initiative and leadership qualities in the program.
- Student has demonstrated a commitment to continue with training to obtain diploma, degree or certification.

D. Aviation Maintenance Engineering Training - \$1,000

Basic Criteria:

Must be at least at the half-way point of an aviation maintenance engineering course, and having intent to continue in apprenticeship training on course completion.

Grade average marks to date _____ (attach copy of transcript).

Include remarks on the following items in an attached narrative:

- Needs financial assistance.
- Has demonstrated personal initiative and leadership qualities in aviation maintenance engineering program.
- Has demonstrated a commitment to obtain an aviation maintenance engineering license.

E. COMMERCIAL PILOT—FLIGHT TRAINING—Jason Ouellet Memorial Bursary--\$1,000.00

Basic Criteria: The narrative summary should have regard to the following criteria--

- The nominated pilot has not had the easiest and smoothest road to achieving their goal.
- The pilot should have a strong desire and determination in addition to having a strong financial need.
- This person does not necessarily have to be a young pilot or a pilot who is performing at the top of their class. The most important criteria for the memorial bursary in Jason's name would be for the candidate to be a well rounded, down to earth individual with a strong desire and determination who has other facets to their life outside of flying. This, of course, in addition to having a heavy financial need.
- A short narrative from the student explaining her/his reasons for meeting the criteria would be helpful

F. PRIVATE PILOT - FLIGHT TRAINING-ANNE AND RUDI BAUER MEMORIAL BURSARY – \$1,000.00

Basic Nominating Criteria: -

Must have completed written exam and may have obtained PPL in 2010

High academic standing. Mark(s) _____ (attach mark transcripts - copy ok)

Include remarks on the following items in an attached narrative:

- Superior flying skills.
- Excellence in airmanship.
- Actively engaged in private pilot training or received PPL in 2010.
- Needs financial assistance to continue training.
- Has demonstrated a commitment to continue with commercial pilot training or involvement in an aviation industry training organisation such as aviation maintenance, airport operations or airline operations.

G. William Templeton AIRPORT OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT Training Bursary – \$1,000.00

Basic Criteria:

Student has completed at least one year (or equivalent) at the educational institution in the above discipline and has at least one more year to complete the training course.

Details

Grade average mark _____ (attach copy of transcript)

Include remarks on the following items in an attached narrative:

- Student has financial need.
- Student has demonstrated personal initiative and leadership qualities in the program.
- Student has demonstrated a commitment to continue with training to obtain diploma, degree or certification.

H. Alexander Holburn Beaudin & Lang LLP Aviation Scholarship, in memory of Ernie Alexander, Q.C. -- \$2,000.00

Basic Criteria:

The recipient must be a student currently enrolled in an Aviation or Aerospace program at a post-secondary institution in British Columbia and have an academic grade average of 75% or higher.

Include remarks on the following items in an attached narrative:

- Student has financial need.
- The recipient will demonstrate achievement in community involvement in an included narrative.
- Student has demonstrated a commitment to continue with training to obtain diploma, degree or certification.

Please indicate the award applied for (or awards) and attach the necessary narrative and submission requirements with your nomination. It is important to submit awards on time with complete and accurate information.
