### **BACK AND BEVINGTON AIR SAFETY AWARD**

In 1964, Back & Bevington Ltd., and Insurance Brokers donated this trophy to reward an organization or person who contributed towards air safety in British Columbia during that year.

The very first reward was given at the 1964 annual general meeting to R.N (Bob) McCollum for making an effective marking of cable crossing VFR flyways that follows rivers and waterways in BC's mountainous areas.

### **M.R. (MAC) MCCUBBIN TROPHY**

This trophy was given to BCAC by Brouwer & Co and General Insurance Adjusters in 1981 in memory of aviation pioneer and insurance adjuster M.R. (Mac) McCubbin. The top aircraft maintenance engineering (AME) student would receive the reward each year, in which the trophy was retained in a glass rewards cabinet at Pacific Vocational Institute's Sea Island Campus and the plaque was kept by the winner.
